PURPOSE OF THE TEEN BOARD OF THE RMHD

The purpose of the Teen board is to encourage high school students to become more active in community service by supporting the RMHD, to create awareness and encourage support of Ronald McDonald House of Dallas in the student's school and community.

TEEN BOARD DESCRIPTION

Teen Board members will receive an orientation to Ronald McDonald House of Dallas at their first meeting in September. Throughout the school year, Teen Board members will plan and attend meetings and various service projects that support the RMHD. Projects include preparing meals for the families staying at the House, hosting activities for children and families and assisting with fundraisers.

LOCATION AND TIME OF MEETINGS

Teen Board meetings are held on the 3rd Sunday of every month (except December) in the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas Community Room at 4707 Bengal Street, Dallas, Texas 75235.

PROGRAM COMMITMENTS

- A one- year commitment with the possibility of continued service throughout high school years.
- A \$40 membership fee
- Attendance at 4 meetings and 4 service events between September and April.
